<p>January's 1st, 3-Alarm Fire</p> <p>Four units of the Rose Creek apartment complex suffered serious damage during this morning's three-alarm fire. The first arriving firefighters reported out with "a two-story apartment building with fire coming out of two units" and immediately requested additional firefighters. The incident commander used the additional firefighters to attack and extinguished the first multi-alarm fire of the year. Apartment management and the American Red Cross are working to provide overnight housing for the displaced families.</p>
