<p>A Family of Three Dallas Citizens Being Mourned by Family Members</p> <p>A 911 call was answered by DPD at the house of 3903 Canada Drive. Upon policing the rear of the house, an officer spotted smoke coming from the eaves and quickly requested that DFR fire crews be dispatched to the residence. Firefighters were met with burglar bars. The burglar bars were sawed off by the use of K-12 saws for gaining entry and thus fire suppression. The fire for the most part was smoldering upon entry by the hose team. Other firefighters began room to room searches discovering a family of three in the house. Firefighters and paramedics quickly removed the victims and immediately began CPR and administering oxygen as additional DFR rescue units were arriving at the fire scene. The victims were transported to Parkland Hospital for continued lifesaving measures. The family was later pronounced deceased by Parkland officials.</p>
