<p><b>Three Alarm Fire In Far North Dallas</b></p> <p>Dallas firefighters battled a fast moving at the Fairways at Remington condominiums in far North Dallas this morning. The resident of the unit where the fire started stated her electricity was disconnected at the time of the fire. The Incident Commander requested additional firefighters to confine the fire damage to one unit of the complex; however, two other units were damaged by smoke, water and firefighting efforts. The American Red Cross is working to meet the immediate needs of the three displaced families.</p> <p>Injuries:</p> <p>1 Firefighter w/ Minor Shoulder Injury – Transported to local medical facility, treated and released</p> <p>1 Firefighter w/ Minor Leg Injury- Treated at the scene, and released to full duty (not transported)</p> <p>1 Civilian/ Occupant w/ Minor Smoke Inhalation, treated at the scene (not transported)</p> <p>Total 3 Injuries</p>
