<p>Fire Crews Free Impaled Construction Worker</p> <p>A worker standing on a small scaffold lost his balance and fell while working at a construction site in the Turtle Creek area. DFR crews found the 30 year-old man impaled on a pole that was projecting approximately 5 feet from the ground. Fire crews were able to cut the pole after 15 minutes while the man remained impaled. He was then treated and transported to a local hospital by a Dallas EMS crew. His condition is not known at this time; however, he appeared to be stable during transport.</p>
