INCIDENT DESCRIPTION					
<p>Two Injuries in West Dallas House Fire</p> <p>Dallas firefighters transported a smoke inhalation/ burn victim to a local medical facility earlier this morning. The occupant of the house, a man believed to be in his 90's was trapped by smoke and fire inside of his single-family home in West Dallas earlier this morning. Prior to the fire departments arrival, a neighbor broke out the injured man's bedroom window and pulled him to safety. The neighbor suffered lacerations and bruises; he initially received medical treatment for his injuries at the scene, and later drove himself to the hospital. The first arriving firefighters reported out with a "lot of smoke and fire" and quickly began fire suppression activities. Dallas Fire Investigators have not determined the cause of the fire at this time.</p> <p>P.S.
