<p>Fire Contained to Bedroom in Apartment Complex</p> <p>Engine 29 was first up on this apartment fire and her crew of firefighters quickly contained the fire to the bedroom of a second story unit. Fire crews gained access through the main entry gate and a locked gate for the initial fire attack. A visiting relative who was present in the apartment had smelled smoke and discovered fire in the bedroom which he unsuccessfully attempted to extinguish with water. One apartment occupant suffered minor smoke inhalation; paramedics treated him on the scene. A tenant's pet Chihuahua was also found in/or out of on of the smoke-filled units and taken to safety by one of the firefighters. Red Cross was called out to fire incident site to assist any tenant affected by the apartment fire.</p> <p>Update: Burning Incense</p>
