<p>Dallas Fire-Rescue Battles 6-Alarm Warehouse Fire</p> <p>On Monday evening Dallas Firefighters were dispatched to a large warehouse located in the 100 block of Glass St. The first arriving units faced a fast moving fire that quickly raced throughout the 40,000 square foot commercial structure; the building housed the Antique Drapery Rod Company, and other smaller businesses. Firefighters initially conducted an interior fire attack, but the dangerous conditions forced the Incident Commander to transition to a defensive posture while continually working to extinguish the fire. Portions of the roof eventually collapsed as firefighter's continued their fire suppression efforts. Firefighters will remain at this location overnight making sure that all hot spots are extinguished. No injuries have been reported as a result of this fire, and Fire Investigators have not determined a fire cause at this time.</p>
