The Dallas Fire & Rescue Department has planned a September 11th remembrance activities to commemorate the fifth anniversary of the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001 and the subsequent losses suffered at the World Trade Center, the Pentagon and in the crash of United Airlines Flight No. 93 in Pennsylvania.

The event will be coordinated to take place at the exact moment the World Trade Center events occurred and will be marked by two periods of silence, one for each of the towers whose collapse took so many lives at 9:05 a.m. and 9:28 a.m., respectively.

The commemoration in Dallas will be observed in conjunction with nationwide salutes to fallen firefighters, law enforcement personnel and civilians alike, and to the extraordinary response of the entire American fire service to the tragic events that have changed all of our lives.

The service will be held at all Dallas fire stations.
