<p><b>Early Morning Alarm Fire Wakes Up The "M Streets"</b></p> <p>The first arriving fire crews reported out with "a vacant two story apartment building with a lot of smoke and fire coming out of the rear of the building". The Incident Commander determined that he needed additional firefighters to extinguish the fire, and requested a four-alarm fire response. Once the defensive fire strategy was successful, firefighters began an interior fire attack and quickly extinguished the fire. Fire Investigators have not determined a cause, and we have no injuries to report at this time.</p>
