<p>2 Paramedic, 2 Civilians Injured In a Vehicle Collision Involving a Rescue</p> <p>Two Firefighters/Paramedics and two civilians were transported to a local hospital with various injuries after a collision on I-35 and Saner in Oak Cliff. The two Paramedics had just left Baylor Hospital and were in route back to the fire station when they were apparently sideswiped by a SUV. The impact pushed the Rescue into the center barrier and caused the SUV to roll over several times. Despite being injured, the two Paramedics immediately began to treat the occupants of the SUV. All four appeared to be in either stable or good condition at a local Hospital.</p>
