| <p><b>Firefighters Battle Early Morning Apartment Fire- One Fatality</b></p> <p>Residences of the Sunrise Village Apartments woke up to a two-alarm fire response shortly after one o'clock this morning. Fire Department dispatchers notified the initial responding South Oak Cliff fire companies that someone might be still inside of the burning apartment unit; however, firefighter's heroic efforts to rescue the 44-year-old female occupant were unsuccessful. The Dallas County Medical Examiner is on location and responsible for determining the cause of death. The victims name has not been released pending notification of the next of kin. Fire Investigators have not determined the cause of the fire at this time.
